Entry Fee	Entry fee is 50c per bird All birds entered must be paid for.
Postage	The Society requests all exhibitors advise if return of stickers by post is required. The amount of \$1.50 will be charged if priority post is required.
Cages	All exhibits to be staged in recognised show cages. At the discretion of the Show Committee any bird in a dirty or badly presented cage will be disqualified from being judged.
Class Labels	To be affixed to right hand side bottom corner of cage.
Floor covering	<b><u>MILLET SPRAY/s</u></b>
Ring numbers	If parent society has issued P.R.B.S. Inc with a current ring list, ring numbers need not be declared on entry form. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to ensure ring list has been supplied. Spot ring checks may be made.
Nest Feathers	Must be rung with a <b>2019</b> closed ring and must be owned and bred by the exhibitor. Split and plastic rings are not permitted. <b>Unisex nestfeather show - use cock line on schedule when nominating.</b>
Young Birds	<b><u>Black and red enclosed ring</u> and must be owned and bred by the exhibitor.</b>
Old Birds	As per SQBBA rules - <b>Unisex Old bird show - use cock line on schedule when nominating.</b>
Staging	All birds to be staged between 7.30 and 8.30 a.m.
Judging	To commence at 9.00 a.m. and will be to the Australian standard.
Judges:	<b><i>As selected by the committee;</i></b>
Lunch	Will be available at a nominal charge.
Presentation	1. p.m. (approximately).
Selling birds	Birds for this section may be entered on the morning of the show. Commission of 10 % of the selling price of a bird will go to P.R.B.S. Inc. A maximum of 4 birds of different colours per cage. Please affix class label to cage, stating your name and the variety, sex and price of birds entered.
